The Outstanding Teacher Programme

OTP

Ignite will be facilitating the Outstanding Teacher Programme

Our OTP programme is open to teachers with the potential and capacity to deliver consistently outstanding lessons. Applicants need to demonstrate:



- A strong commitment to learning and teaching, and show that they have strong interpersonal skills
- At least three years' teaching experience of value added data showing student progress and improving exam results.
- A commitment to professional development and the ability to truly reflect on their practice, including using student feedback to evaluate the impact of their teaching.

Programme Structure

The programme consists of two full days and eight half `day sessions over a ten week period. It is delivered through face-to-face taught sessions, classroom observations and learning walks within the host school. During 5 weeks of the programme sessions are based on 'in school' activities.

What does the OTP involve?

The OTP:

- Provides in-depth coaching to deepen teachers' understanding of outstanding practice
- Delegates improve through facilitated practice activities giving structured opportunities to reflect on teaching approaches and their impact
- Introduces and consolidates new knowledge and related to outstanding learning and teaching.
- Requires 'learning threes' to prepare and present at an outstanding level to the whole delegate group

Commitment

The programme works best if schools are able to send three teachers on the same course, so staff can work in 'learning threes'. However 'learning threes' can be formed from local cluster schools. You will also have to nominate an in school coach to support participants with post session challenges and give time to participants to collaborate in school. Time will also need to be allocated each week to give delegates the opportunity to collaborate on post session challenges.
